The Commissioner of Health, Medical Services and Medical Education (ME), Gandhinagar vide their single file referred to at no. 3 above has submitted proposal for a change in the rule 8 of above mentioned rules.

After careful consideration, Government has decided to substitutes Rule No. 8 of G.R. Dated the 11/12/2014 referred to No. 4 above and now, Rule No. 8 should be read as under,

"8. Merit for the purpose of transfer will be based on the marks obtained at the HSC Examination conducted by the Gujarat Higher Secondary Education Board/Central Board of Secondary Education/Council of Indian School Certificate Examination and the 1st MBBS University Examination. In this 50 % weightage shall be given to the total marks obtained in the four semesters of std. 11 and 12 of HSC Examination in the theory papers of Science subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) and 50 % weightage to the total percentage of marks obtained at the 1st MBBS University Examination in theory and practical for the purpose of preparing the merit list. Transfer shall be given only to those students who pass the HSC and 1st MBBS examination at the first attempt."
